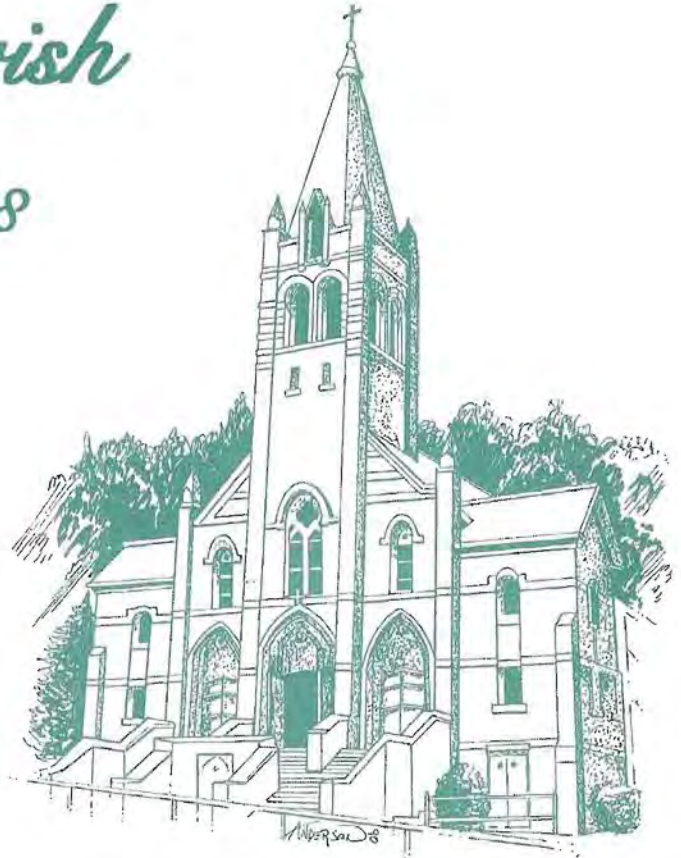

**BOŻE CIAŁO**

*„Ja jestem chlebem żywym, który zstąpił z nieba”*

Chleb powszedni jest owocem ziemi. Ten chleb – dar ziemi – daje nam siłę do poruszania się wśród rzeczywistości ziemskich. Mocą tego chleba możemy iść przez ziemię jak prorok Elias, który „szedł mocą tego pokarmu”. Z tego chleba, który jest z ziemi czerpiemy siłę do pracy i do władania tym światem.



Dzisiaj gromadzimy się jednak wokół innego chleba. Ten chleb jest z nieba. Tym chlebem jest Eucharystia – Najświętsze Ciało i Krew Chrystusa. Spożywanie tego chleba daje siłę do poruszania się wśród rzeczywistości niebieskich. Ten chleb wzmacnia nie tkanki ciała, lecz władze duszy. Dzięki niemu możemy nawiązywać coraz żywszą łączność z tym, co duchowe. Przyjmowanie Eucharystii – chleba z nieba – umacnia naszą wiarę, nadzieję i miłość, udoskonala naszą modlitwę, dzięki czemu już teraz, coraz swobodniej, możemy poruszać się w domu Ojca, który jest w niebie.

## THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST

**“As the day was drawing to a close, the Twelve approached him and said, ‘dismiss the crowd so they can go to the surrounding villages and farms and find lodging and provisions, for we are in a deserted place here.’ He said to them, ‘Give them some food yourselves.’ They replied ‘five loaves and two fish are all we have, unless we ourselves go and buy food for these people...’”**

How often the gospel of Luke shows compassion and concern. He paints a picture, including the time of day, the nature of the location and the needs of the people. For Jesus it is an opportunity, not just to feed the multitude but to teach the apostles and subtly provide for something greater.

The greater gift is the Eucharist when He feeds us with His Body and Blood. Paul speaks of the tradition he received, written even prior to the gospel stories of the Last Supper. He handed on to us what was given to Him, the story of the final gathering of Jesus with the apostles.

How important to take this event a step further. Jesus says to us ‘Give them some food yourselves.’ We might do that literally serving in a food pantry, providing monies for food banks, or taking a meal to someone who is homebound or alone. We feed others with kindness and care, friendship and support, especially those who seem to be deserted or abandoned by others. The corporal works of mercy are signs that what happened there continues to occur today...

The passage concludes by saying: ‘they all ate and were satisfied.’ I am sure this refers to Jesus, the Twelve, the multitude, and the people the Lord wants us to serve.
